Mike Roland, senior scientist for Soft Matter Physics (Code 6105), received the Colwyn medal from Professors Serena Best (University Cambridge) and James Busfield (Queen Mary University London) during a ceremony at the International Rubber Conference in London last week. He was cited for "outstanding services to the rubber industry of a scientific, technical or engineering character". Sponsored by the Institute for Materials, Metals, and Mining (UK), the medal was first awarded in 1928, and Roland is only the fourth American recipient.
